This training event is an extended project from 2021 Pacific Partnership, NCDR and CFE-DM work together again to enhance the capacity of disaster risk reduction and response of the Asia-Pacific and Indo-Pacific region.

Dr. Tsung-Tsong Wu, the Minister of National Science and Technology Council (NSTC) of Taiwan delivered the opening remarks for this training workshop virtually.
